There is some revenue available now for urgent problems and it is anticipated that some re-surfacing/repair works will be done in the village in the next two to three weeks. Interim Road Safety Survey is ready with the intention that the final report be made available for March. There have been 402 responses: 66% in favour of a 20mph limit in the village 58% in favour of traffic calming on Black Dyke Road and Redhills Road 71% in favour of a motorhome ban on the Promenade 38% in favour of removing double yellow lines on Redhills Road with a significant number requesting more double yellow lines on Redhills Road. Results to be discussed in more detail at a future meeting of the APC on a date to be confirmed. PSPO for playing field to be chased up by the Cllr McSweeney. A Councillor asked who is responsible for the clearing of gullies to ensure that water can freely run away under the railway bridge out of Arnside. Cllr McSweeney explained that the County Council is responsible for clearing the gullies and the Environment Agency is responsible for making sure that water can flow freely from the drainage system.
