* Subject to availability, individuals who are not resident in **Arnside, Carr Bank or Storth** may purchase a grave space. However, in such cases the purchaser would be classed as a non-resident.

** It is not possible to tell until the first interment whether a second burial can be accommodated, if the Council find it impracticable (owing to drainage or other cause) to dig to a depth of 7 feet in any particular grave space then it may be possible to transfer to an alternative plot. Please note a transfer fee will be applicable.

*** The definition of a child's grave is a grave specifically allocated for the burial of a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 18 years.

**** The Gravedigger's costs are additional and are not included above. These are paid through the appointed Funeral Director. Only the approved Gravedigger(s) for Arnside is/are allowed to carry out this function.

Additional Guidance

The Parish Council fees are normally paid by clients through their appointed Funeral Director or monumental mason, whose responsibility it is to pay the Parish Council.

For the interment of Cremated remains, if no Funeral Director is involved, the interment fees are made payable directly to Arnside Parish Council. A separate payment to be made to the appointed gravedigger (Level of charge from Cemetery Officer).

Burials and interments are not permitted to take place at weekends as the Cemetery does not have the staff available to oversee such arrangements.

The Cemetery Officer is available in normal working hours (on a part time basis) to answer queries on fees or other cemetery enquiries.
